SERVICE NOTICE

COVID-19 Response: Rigging, Scaffold and Concrete Safety Refresher Training Card and Certificates Require Renewal by November 9, 2020

All refresher training program requirements for site safety training cards or certificates required by [Sections 3314.4.5 or 3316.9.2 of the New York City Building Code](#) and [Section 104-06 of Title 1 of the Rules of the City of New York](#) that were suspended by [Mayoral Emergency Executive Order No. 120](#), are now suspended through November 9, 2020, per Mayoral Emergency Executive Order No. 149.

The following are the refresher training program requirements that have been suspended by executive order until November 9, 2020:

- 8-hour Rigging Worker refresher (see BC3316.9.2)
- 16-hour Rigging Worker (see BC3316.9.2)
- 32-hour Rigging Supervisor (see BC3316.9.2)
- 16-hour Rigger Supervisor refresher (see BC3316.9.2)
- 4-hour Supported Scaffold User and refresher (see BC3314.4.5)
- 32-hour Supported Scaffold Installer and Remover (see BC3314.4.5)
- 8-hour Supported Scaffold Installer and Remover refresher (see BC3314.4.5)
- 32-hour Suspended Scaffold Supervisor (see BC3314.4.5)
- 8-hour Suspended Scaffold Supervisor refresher (see BC3314.4.5)
- 8-hour Concrete Safety Manager refresher (see Rule 104-06)

Any training card or certificate that has expired during the time period covered by Executive Orders 120 and 149 must be renewed by November 9, 2020.
